MEDICAL EQUIPMENT & SUPPLIES

New and gently used folding walkers, crutches, canes, wheelchairs, shower chairs, and orthopedic supplies.



TOOLS

New and gently used brooms, hand tools, and metal garden implements (including shovels, rakes, and hoes)



EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT AND GEAR

Including fire gear and equipment, firetrucks, and ambulances. Fire gear can be expired.

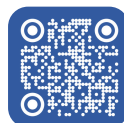

MIDWEST MISSION KITS

REQUIREMENTS

- All Kit items must be NEW.
- Kits should contain ONLY the requested items.
- No camouflage on fabrics.

PERSONAL DIGNITY KIT



- 1 Hand towel - no kitchen towels
- 1 Washcloth - no dishcloths
- 1 Adult toothbrush — individually packaged
- 1 Bar soap - 3-4 oz
- 1 Shampoo - 12-19 oz - lid taped
- 1 Deodorant - 2-3 oz - stick, roll on, or pump
- 1 Lotion - 8-10 oz - lid taped
- 1 One-gallon resealable plastic bag

Place all items in the resealable plastic bag.
\$2 donation for toothpaste and carrying bag.

STUDENT KIT



- 3 Notebooks - 1 subject spiral 8"x 10 1/2"
- 1 Ruler - 12" long with metric
- 6 Pencils - unsharpened
- 1 Pencil sharpener
- 1 Eraser - 2" or larger
- 1 Box 12 colored pencils
- 1 Box 24 crayons
- 1 Pair student scissors
- 1 One-handled cloth bag*

Place all items in the cloth bag or a grocery sack.

HOME CARE KIT



- Liquid household cleaner - 56-80 oz total - no pump or spray bottles
- Dish soap - 42-64 oz total
- Liquid laundry detergent - 100-150 oz total
- 1 Scrub brush - with or without handle
- 1 Five-gallon round bucket with resealable lid

Place all items in the bucket.

BIRTHING KIT



- 1 Hand towel - no kitchen towels
- 1 Washcloth - no dishcloths
- 1 Bar soap - 3-4 oz
- 2 Contractor bags or heavy duty trash bags (2 mil+ thickness)
- 2 Receiving blankets* - 28"x 28" to 32"x 32" - no fleece or thermal blankets
- 1 One-gallon resealable plastic bag

Place all items in the resealable plastic bag.
\$3 donation for umbilical cord clamps, sterile surgical gloves, and scalpel.

FEMININE HYGIENE KIT



- 1 Hand towel - no kitchen towels
- 1 Washcloth - no dishcloths
- 1 Bar soap - 3-4 oz
- 3 Pairs underwear - sizes: girls 10-14, women 5-8
- 6 Day pads*
- 3 Night pads*
- 1 Drawstring carrying bag *
- 1 Waterproof bag *
- 1 One-handled cloth bag *

Place all items in the cloth bag.

LAYETTE KIT



All Items must be size 0-6 months

- 6 Cloth diapers*
- 2 Gowns* or sleepers
- 2 Onesies or undershirts
- 2 Infant washcloths - no adult washcloths
- 6 Diaper pins - must have protective plastic closures
- 1 Sweater* or jacket* with front opening - no ties
- 2 Receiving blankets* - 28"x 28" to 32"x 32" - no fleece or thermal blankets.

Bundle items inside one of the blankets and secure with diaper pins.

\$2 donation for diaper cream.

TORNADO KIT



- 2 Pairs work gloves
- 24 One-gallon resealable plastic bags
- 2 Permanent markers
- 1 Roll colored duct tape - 15-20 yd
- 2 Dust masks - no surgical masks
- 24 Heavy-duty trash bags - 33-45 gal

\$20 donation for two 18-gallon totes.

Kit will be assembled at Midwest Mission.

BED PACK



- 1 Twin-size fitted sheet
- 1 Twin-size flat sheet
- 1 Pillow case
- 1 Bed pillow

Place all items in an unscented trash bag.
