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Layette Diaper Instructions

Please use NEW flannel fabric.

Please do NOT use fabric with camouflage.

Cutting:

Cut 2 layers of flannel for each diaper

New flannel, terry cloth, or cotton batting may be used for padding. Using the pattern, cut layers of padding. Sewers may use their discretion on how many layers of padding to use, but as a general guide, padding for each diaper should measure between 1/4" and 1/2" when stacked.

Sewing:

1. Layer padding lengthwise centered on wrong side of one diaper layer.
2. Using zig zag stitch, sew 4 layers of padding to wrong side of one diaper layer.
- 3 step zig zag works well to catch all the edges of the padding.



3. Put right sides of diaper together and stitch (3/8" seam allowance) all around leaving 4" opening for turning
4. Turn, with right sides out, top stitch 1/4" from the edge all around the edges
5. Sew large X inside the oval (to hold padding in place).
