Shipment to Jamaica meets needs witnessed by Midwest Mission staff members



At the end of March 2023, three Midwest Mission staff members — Chantel Corrie (Executive Director), Barb Hedinger (Volunteer Coordinator), and Mallory Webster (Communications Manager) — traveled to Kingston, Jamaica to visit places that receive Midwest Mission items, and to witness the need first-hand. The trip was through Food For The Poor, Midwest Mission's biggest international partner. Jamaica was the first country Food For The Poor served, so this was the perfect country to visit for the first trip.

As they walked the halls of an old hospital, ventured down the road of a campus for disabled children and adults, looked into the eyes of prisoners ready to turn their



lives around, and walked hand-in-hand with children who have been given hope through a new family at a children's home ... the needs were evident. But so was God.

God was near to those going through pain and heartache in the hospital. He could be felt in the chapel of the home for the disabled. You could see him in the eye of the prisoner who would receive a sewing machine upon being released. God was at the forefront of the minds of the directors of the homeless shelter, the "aunties" at the children's homes, and the staff of Food For The Poor itself. These servants of God not only take care of the physical needs of those they encounter, but pay careful attention to their spiritual needs.

Whether at the hospital, care center for the homeless, or an infirmary for those "homeless, familyless, and friendless," the need was evident — mattresses.

Many times, one of the organizations might receive a bed and a mattress, but the mattress is used so much, and often soiled, that the mattress wears out, leaving nothing but a bed frame. Midwest Mission staff members witnessed people sleeping on cardboard laid on top of a hard bed frame, injured patients sitting in a crowded waiting room because of a lack of beds and mattresses, and desperate caretakers asking for mattresses because of what they see on a daily basis.



The good news is, our God is a God who perfectly orchestrates His plan.

The three staff members returned to Midwest Mission with hearts broken for what breaks God's heart, and a list of needs that they had witnessed, one of the top priorities being mattresses and medical supplies.

On the first Monday back at

Midwest Mission, Chantel and Mallory walked to the third warehouse for break time. As they turned the corner, they could see piles stacked 10 feet in the air. They peered around the pallet racking to get a better look. There, in the middle of the third warehouse, were stacks and stacks of *mattresses*.

Little did they know, while they were in Jamaica seeing the vast need for mattresses, Ramon Ortiz, Operations Specialist, was traveling to Southern Illinois to pick up a load of donated mattresses.

Our God works in mysteriously perfect ways.

It was quickly decided that these mattresses would go to Jamaica to be distributed to some of the same organizations where they had seen the desperate need for mattresses.

On Wednesday, May 3, that shipment came to life. The container backed into the loading dock, the fork lifts revved, and supplies were moved into the container.

We always send what is asked for, but how much greater is it when we can hear the ask in-person, and make it happen just one month later. We were able to send exactly what they needed because God knew those needs.

This shipment contained 34 mattresses. It also included 25 bikes, 334 little girl outfits, 304 Cover Them With Love Quilts, 83 tarps from Lamar Advertising, medical supplies such as gauze, syringes, bandages, sanitary wipes, linens, gloves, masks, a phlebotomy chair, walkers, crutches, canes, wheelchairs, and so much more.

We are able to show God's love in a practical way in Jamaica because YOU listen to the nudge to pray, donate, and serve. You are part of God's plan at Midwest Mission.

It is an honor and a blessing to be a part of this ministry, and to see God at work.

Children receive Student Kits in Honduras



Notebooks, pencils, eraser, pencil sharpener, crayons, colored pencils, ruler, and scissors — typical school supplies you'd find in most students' backpacks or desks during the school year in the United States.

But for many families in Honduras, they don't have the financial means to purchase these educational tools. Honduras is very impoverished, "with the highest level of income inequality in all of Latin America" (Food For the Poor). Over 65 percent of the population lives in poverty, with circumstances worsening for those in rural areas and indigenous people.

The country itself is vulnerable to devastating natural disasters, and Hondurans are vulnerable to other disasters: crime, malnutrition, and unemployment.

Sometimes, in the face of all the disasters, it is easy to lose hope. That's why we send the things we do — so that people can have what they need to thrive and gain back some of the hope and independence that was lost through their crisis.

Midwest Mission was recently able to bless Honduras with two shipments, including many needed Student Kits that contain the typical school supplies listed above. Midwest Mission, Food For The Poor, and their in-country partners all understand the necessity of education, and how fundamental it is in a country's development.



We received feedback from two different communities in Honduras.

The first community distributed **280 Student Kits** to children at the local school.

"The Student Kits were most popular among the children since they look forward to

getting new school supplies for the new school year," Heydy Bu, Food For The Poor's in-country partner representative said. "With the items contained in the kits, I can tell you that their wish list was fulfilled. Thank you for these wonderful kits for our students!"

The second community was a rural area called La Esperanza Intibucá.

"When we receive donations that contain school supplies, we try to reach children from families with limited financial resources, especially those who live in remote, rural areas," Heydy said.

"La Esperanza Intibucá is one such area. It is comprised of twin cities, and it is home to the indigenous Lenca community. Many people living there have makeshift homes with dirt floors and roofs made of sheet metal."

They provided Student Kits to **50 children** in this community.

Thank YOU to everyone who made this



happen. Your prayers, volunteer hours, and donations (both monetary and in-kind) allow children in Honduras to have the proper tools needed to excel in school.

Solar Panel Installation Begins



In 2020, Midwest Mission's board of directors and staff began to dream and plan what it would look like for Midwest Mission to have solar panels. With a desire to steward resources well, and go more "green," the Solar Project began.

The plans were made, and God continually showed up, orchestrating the work and connections in his perfect timing. This has been a long process as we fundraised, prayed, and waited for the construction to start, but we are excited for the end-result and the good it will do for the ministry.

This week, after a year of anticipation, the Solar Panels were installed on the warehouses.

The total project cost was \$154,986, but with \$66,632 of incentives, the net cost was \$88,354.

The best part? The estimated 25-year electric bill savings is \$308,494. Meaning, every \$1 that was donated to the campaign will save us a minimum of \$3.50 in electric costs.

Thank you for continuing to prioritize the stewardship of the resources God gives us. God continues to bless Midwest Mission in unthinkable ways!

Angels of Hope Items Delivered to Children in Honduras



Honduras, located in Central America, is a beautiful country, but one that is full of challenges. Honduras is very impoverished, with unemployment, gang violence, malnutrition, and lack of opportunity being the main causes of suffering.

People in Honduras lack resources that are common for many of us — food, hygiene supplies, cleaning supplies, etc.

We have the opportunity to bless those who are in need with the resources that can propel them into a better life. We work with Food For The Poor to serve communities of Honduras.

One of the ways we partner with Food For The Poor is through their Angels of Hope Program. The program's goal is to "improve the lives of vulnerable children who come from poverty and/or have been abandoned or removed from their homes due to a dangerous or at-risk situation." They work with children's homes across the Caribbean and Latin America to meet basic needs that the homes have trouble providing.

We received photos from a few Angels of Hope homes in Honduras who received

Home Care Kits and Personal Dignity Kits.

"Without donations such as these that encompass the spectrum of tangible needs, the standard of personal hygiene and cleanliness that we see in the homes would not be sustainable," Food For The Poor's in-country representative, Heydy, said.

"This type of donation is of great need. We pray that God continues to bless the donors in abundance and that we continue to receive these much-needed essentials that are truly a blessing."

22nd International Shipment of the Year Heads to Ethiopia



On Monday, May 22, we loaded the 22nd international shipment of the year. Its final destination is Ethiopia.

This shipment is for our partner, North Star Foundation, who we previously worked with for Ukraine and Turkey. North Star shared with us the vast needs they see in Ethiopia. Within weeks, we were ready to ship.

This shipment contained:

- 392,000 surgical gloves
- 48,619 hospital gowns
- 3,800 disposable shoe covers
- 3,200 hair nets
- 212,960 disposable face masks
- 240,000 bed pads
- Disinfecting wipes

This shipment weighed 31,614 lbs and was valued at \$569,446.14.
