

Fleece Baby Jacket Instructions

Do NOT use fabric that has a camouflage pattern

Material Needed:

- 1. Polar Fleece: 1 yard of fleece will make 4 jackets.
- 2. Three snaps

Sewing Steps:

- 1. Cut fleece using pattern.
- 2. Using $\frac{3}{8}$ inch seams throughout, sew back to front at top shoulders. Top stitch seam toward back.
- 3. Fold along 1 inch casing line on each center front with right sides together. Sew along the top neck and bottom hem edges. Invert to form the casing. Topstitch on both long edges of the casing to finish.
- 4. Attach sleeve to each side of jacket matching centers and easing fabric to match. Top stitch seam toward sleeve.
- 5. Turn under raw edge of sleeve cuffs and zigzag the hems.
- 6. Sew side and underarm seams of jacket. Top stitch side portion toward back stopping at sleeve.
- 7. Turn under neck edge and bottom jacket edge and use a zigzag stitch to finish.
- 8. Add 3 snaps to the casing at markings on pattern.
